Al Iman College also offers the following educational services to students:

- Daily Salat program our day starts with Salat (Prayer). We offer Zohar Salat (Prayer) at lunch time.
- Tarbiyah (Islamic studies) including Fiqh (Islamic Jurisprudence), Ahadith (Sayings of Prophet Mohammad , Sayings of Prophet Mohammad , Tarikh (Islamic History), Aqaid (Articles of Faith), Akhlaq (Character and Morals) and Adab (Islamic Manners and Islamic Etiquettes)
- Quran lessons reading and memorising
- Extracurricular activities Quran Competition, Eid celebrations, interest clubs, incursions and excursions and sports program for all students that may include interschool sporting activities
- ♣ A LOTE program currently inclusive of the Arabic language only



- Annual Camps for secondary students
- Workshops for all students for social and emotional learning
- ♣ Parent information sessions and seminars regularly which are essential for parents to attend.
- We offer coeducational classes from Foundation to Year 2 and segregated girls and boys classes from Years 3 to 12.
